Qualified men of the Orthodox Jewish faith are eligible for admission to Yeshiva Gedola Amidei Dgirsra without regard to age, race, color, national origin or physical handicap. The yeshiva is also an equal opportunity employer and is in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disability Act of 1992.

Beyond equal access, opportunity and accommodation, the yeshiva is committed to the understanding, sensitivity, patience, encouragement and support that are essential in guaranteeing to all qualified students the same educational experience and environment as well as the equal opportunity to learn and study at the institution.
